Glidden Community Gardens

The Glidden Community Gardens are divided into 10 x 20' individual garden plots. A group, family or individual may sign up for one or two garden plots. The annual fee per plot is \$20. The gardens are located just north of 10th Street and the Methodist Church. Tillage and water will be provided by the City of Glidden. To sign up for a garden plot please stop by the city office or call 659-3010.



Open Burning Prohibited

All open burning is prohibited. All landscape waste; shrub or tree trimmings should be taken to the City's brush piles east of the Sewer Treatment Plant

Glidden Aquatic Membership

You may purchase your Glidden Aquatic Center season memberships at the Glidden City office during business hours. Family membership (immediate only) is \$150. Single membership is \$90. Early Family Memberships paid on or before May 15th will receive \$10 off the membership price. City of Glidden utility customers will receive an additional \$5.00 off the family membership. Daily admission for all ages is \$5.00, children under 3 with a paying adult is \$1.00.

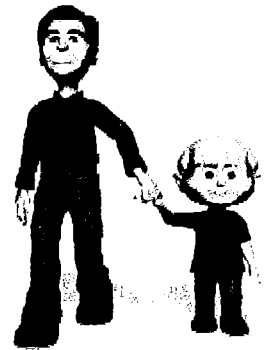


Call Before You Dig!
