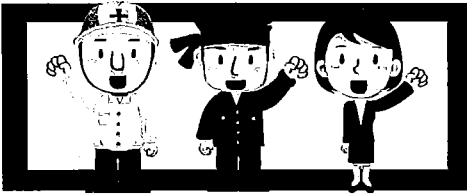

Turning Off Your Utilities?

Need your utilities turned off...call the City office for an appointment! The City requires a minimum of 72 hours notice before we can turn off your water and power. You need to be present when the city crew or PeopleService turns off your utilities. Unless an emergency exists that threatens safety, public works and PeopleService are available for utility turn offs between 7:00 AM and 3:30 PM Monday through Friday.

2013 Street Improvement Progress

The 2013 Street Improvement projects have shown a lot of progress in August. Sherwood Avenue was poured on August 12th and East 1st Street in front of NEW Cooperative was poured on Friday, August 23rd. After the two streets have cured and sealed, the shoulders will be improved and open for traffic! The contractor, Smith Concrete, will move to the Northland Park trail to remove the asphalt and replace with concrete.
