“Junk” In Yards Prohibited

Fireworks

Glidden Fireworks ordinance amended to stricter time period. Fireworks are allowed July 1-8 & December 31-January 1 during the hours of 5:00 pm to 10:00 pm only.

Glidden City Code prohibits the accumulation of things such as tires, inoperable or unlicensed cars, and other types of “junk.” Violators may be fined \$100 per occurrence. Junk cars can be subject to impoundment. Race cars may also be considered junk cars depending upon condition. Aquatic Center Guidelines

TEST. MARK. PROTECT

The Glidden Aquatic Center will have different requirements when entering the pool this year. Please be aware of this when entering the pool this upcoming season:



TEST: Deep water/water slide swim test

PLUNGE: Jump into the water that is over patron head and easily return to the surface.

TREAD: Keep head above water while treading for 60 seconds.

SWIM: Swim one length of the pool (25yards) unassisted and without resting.



MARK:

GREEN BAND: Swimmers that pass the test may access all pool areas

NO BAND: Non-swimmers who do not take the test or fail the test will be restricted from the diving and water slide area.

PROTECT:

All non-swimmers 10 and under must be accompanied in the water by an actively engaged adult 18 years or older within arm’s reach
