Aquatic Center Guidelines TEST. MARK. PROTECT

The Glidden Aquatic Center will have different requirements when entering the pool this year. Please be aware of this when entering the pool this upcoming season:

TEST: Deep water/water slide swim test

PLUNGE: Jump into the water that is over patron head and easily return to the surface.

TREAD: Keep head above water while treading for 60 seconds.

SWIM: Swim one length of the pool (25yards) unassisted and without resting.

MARK:

GREEN BAND: Swimmers that pass the test may access all pool areas

NO BAND: Non-swimmers who do not take the test or fail the test will be restricted from the diving and water slide area.

PROTECT:

All non-swimmers 10 and under must be accompanied in the water by an actively engaged adult 16 years or older within arm's reach. One adult can be responsible for no more than 3 non-swimmers during open swim.

2021 Spring Clean-up

The City of Glidden is excited to offer a new curbside Spring clean-up option for residential customers on the first Friday in May each year.

2021 Collection date: May 7, 2021

Guidelines:

- Limit one pickup truck bed load per house.
- Make sure your items are stacked neatly at the curb by 6 am on the scheduled clean-up day as the truck will only stop at your house one time.
- Non-accepted items will be left at the curb if they are placed out during clean-up day.
- Do not set out your regular garbage container for this collection.
- Do not set out any additional garbage containers or totes full of debris unless you want everything removed including the containers. Any items accidentally thrown away cannot be retrieved.
- A list of accepted and non-accepted examples are below.
- Sorry, no appliances.
