## Glidden Community Gardens

## Off Road Vehicle Registration

Residents may now register their Off-Road Utility Vehicle at the Glidden City Office. Off-Road vehicles include golf carts and utility vehicles with a bench seat. Straddle seat off-road vehicles may be driven on the City streets for work purposes only. All off-road vehicles must be registered at the Glidden City office. All off-road vehicles shall be equipped with a regulation slow moving vehicle sign, bicycle safety flag, and permit stickers. All vehicles must be insured. The annual registration fee is \$20.
