Aquatic Center Guidelines TEST. MARK. PROTECT

The Glidden Aquatic Center will have different requirements when entering the pool this year. Please be aware of this when entering the pool this upcoming season:

TEST: Deep water/water slide swim test,

PLUNGE: Jump into the water that is over patron head and easily return to the surface.

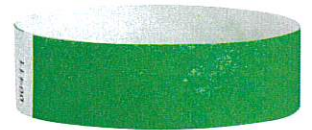
TREAD: Keep head above water while treading for 60 seconds.

SWIM: Swim one length of the pool (25yards) unassisted and without resting.

MARK:

GREEN BAND: Swimmers that pass the test may access all pool areas.

NO BAND: Non-swimmers who do not take the test or fail the test will be restricted from the diving and water slide area.



PROTECT:

All non-swimmers 10 and under must be accompanied in the water by an actively engaged adult 16 years or older within arm's reach. Each person 16 years and younger will be tested for a wrist band. All green bands must be worn at all times when at the pool. A new band will be reissued each time you enter the pool (if you pass the swim test).

Brush Pile Regulations

The City brush pile is open for Glidden residents only. The City reminds its residents that only tree limbs, brush and grass clippings which were generated within the City limits may be taken to the City's brush pile. Please remove all plastic bags from the brush pile. It is a violation of the City Code to use the brush pile for anything other than this use. Violators may receive a fine of up to \$100 for the first violation and up to \$200 for each subsequent violation. Many residents appreciate the use of the brush pile - please observe these rules so that the brush pile can remain a community asset.

Building Permit Regulations

Don't forget to apply for a building permit, when you are planning to make changes on your property. In addition to new homes, examples of items that need a building permit are a garage, patio, deck, driveways, and sidewalks. Building permits are \$10 and applications are available online or at the City Office. Building Permits have to be approved by City Council before you begin work. (Council meets 2nd and 4th Mondays of the month need to have packet in the Wednesday before meeting)

Penalty Notice: Where work is started or commenced without obtaining a building permit, a fee in the amount of \$100-\$150 will be assessed to the property owner. The payment of such fee shall not relieve any person from fully complying with the requirements of the City code in the execution of the work, nor from any other penalties prescribed therein.
