2020-2021 IOWA OME ENERGY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

WHEN TO APPLY:

- * Elderly (60 & over) and/or disabled:
October 1, 2020 to April 30, 2021
- * All other households:
November 1, 2020 to April 30, 2021

WHAT TO TAKE:

- * Proof of Income (for all household members age 19, and over)
Check stubs from the previous 30 days, award letter from Social Security or 2019 tax return
- * Social Security numbers for all household members (documentation required)
- * Recent heat bill
- * Recent electric bill

WAGE EARNERS:

Please bring copies of your check stubs for the 30-day period preceding the date of application, or a copy of your federal income tax return.

FIXED INCOME:

This income may include: Social Security Benefits, Supplemental Security Income, Family Investment Program, Veteran's Assistance, Unemployment Insurance, and pensions. Please bring copies of your most check stubs from previous 30 days.

SELF-EMPLOYED/FARMERS:

Please bring a copy of your most recent federal income tax return.

FIP RECIPIENTS:

Please bring your current DHS Notice of Decision or contact your local office for acceptable document information.

You also need to verify alimony or child support, received.

Project Share Grants Available

Applications for a \$50 Project Share grant are available at the Glidden City office. Eligible applicants may apply once per winter heating season. Applicants must match \$25 of their own funds to receive a total of \$75 toward their City heating bill. Funding available until depleted.
