Community Garden Rules and Responsibilities

Read the following information carefully:

- Produce grown is for personal consumption, donation, or resale
- Plots are available to all families or individuals in the Glidden area.
- There is a \$20.00 annual fee per plot.
- Gardeners may sign up for a maximum of two plots.
- Gardeners are responsible for planting, cultivating and maintaining/weeding their own plots.
- Gardeners are responsible for keeping the weeds in the plots to a minimum.
- Plant vines should be kept within the plot, or risk being mowed off.
- Care must be taken with water usage, so as not to waste water.
- Perennial crops that are planted are not guaranteed for future years because of annual tillage.
- Chemical weed killers and Insecticides may be used within reasonable and recommended rates, but must not be allowed to drift to other plots.
- Chemical and organic fertilizer may be used within reasonable and recommended rates.
- Gardeners are responsible for assisting in the maintenance of common areas.
- Plastic mulch may be used but must be cleaned up at the end of the season.
- Trellises are allowed if not more than 3 feet in height and removed for fall cleanup.
- Tires or other large debris are not allowed at the site.
- All trash is the responsibility of the gardener and must be taken away from the Community Garden.
- Disrespectful or abusive language or destructive behavior can result in immediate loss of all gardening privileges and forfeiture of any crop remaining in your plot(s).
- Loud music and smoking is prohibited.
- Pets are not allowed in the garden area.
- Gardeners are expected to have their plot cleaned up and all waste and structures removed by October 10 annually.

I have read the Community Garden Rules and Responsibilities and the general information and understand that failure to comply with the rules will result in the loss of my current and/or future gardening privileges.
