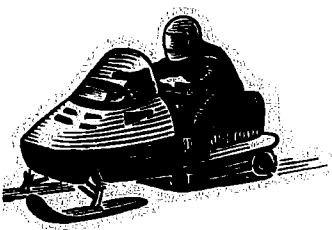
Golf Cart Registration

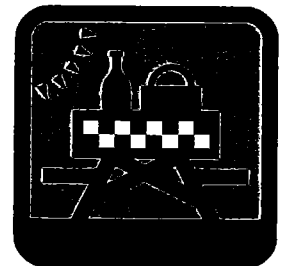
Snowmobile Warning
