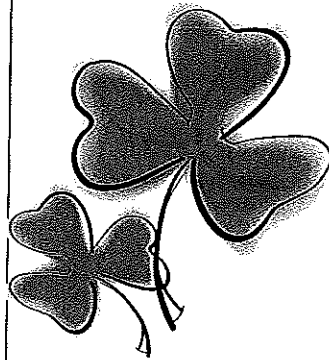

BUILDING PERMITS

In addition to new homes, examples of items that need a building permit are a garage, patio, deck, drive-ways, and sidewalks. Building permits are \$10 and applications are available at the City Office.

Where do I put my Cart in the winter?



Please remember that your garbage cart must be accessible 18 inches from the curb. Your clean driveway approach may be the best option during heavy snow times. Please do not place your cart on city streets. City snowplows cannot clear snow properly when carts are placed on city streets. Point the cart wheels and the handle facing your home. Make sure your container is at least three feet from other containers, parked cars, mailbox posts, etc. Close lid, grasp container handles firmly with both hands and wheel the container to the curb.

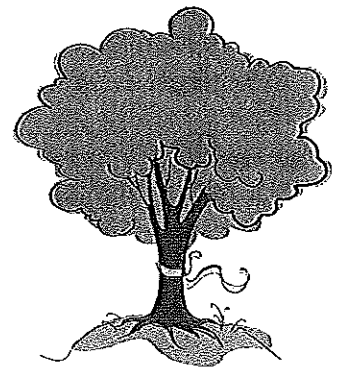
Benefits of Trees
