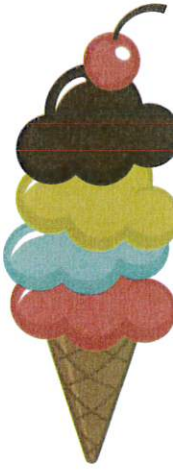

TEST: Deep water/water slide swim test

PLUNGE: Jump into the water that is over patron head and easily return to the surface.

TREAD: Keep head above water while treading for 60 seconds.

SWIM: Swim one length of the pool (25yards) unassisted and without resting.

MARK:

GREEN BAND: Swimmers that pass the test may access all pool areas.

NO BAND: Non-swimmers who do not take the test or fail the test will be restricted from the diving and water slide area.

PROTECT:

All non-swimmers 10 and under must be accompanied in the water by an actively engaged adult 16 years or older within arm's reach. Each person 16 years and younger will be tested for a wrist band. All green bands must be worn at all times when at the pool. You will be tested and if passed you will be put into a log system and wouldn't have to test again. A new band will be reissued each time you enter the pool (if you pass the swim test). One adult can be responsible for no more than 3 non-swimmers during open swim.

Other Rules/ Reminders:

1. Remember— lifeguards are not babysitters. They provide a secondary barrier, assisting in emergencies and prevention when possible. It is important that you or the supervising individual for your child is watching them while they swim. Children 9 and under must have in-water supervision when water is over chest height.

2. No extended breath holding— Extended breath holding can cause any age, person or ability to pass out underwater and drown, called shallow water blackout. Avoid hyperventilating or breath holding for long periods of time.

3. The Glidden Aquatic Center reserves the right to refuse admittance to, or eject from the aquatic center premises, any person failing to comply with rules for the health and safety of the patrons of the Glidden Aquatic Center.

4. Cooperate with staff—Rules are created to keep all patrons and staff safe and reduce the risk of injury. While some rules may seem arbitrary, they are based on manufactures' liability, state pool codes and national aquatic standards.

5. Ask questions— Managers at the Glidden Aquatic Center are easy to spot in bright yellow shirts or red lifeguards gear, so please feel free to ask them questions. Please avoid talking to the lifeguards on the stands as they are busy scanning the water.
